These are to will & require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him ye sd number of acres in ye afore-mention'd County in a place not already taken up according to ye methad of townships appointed by me & make returns thereof into my Secretary's office. Given at Philadelphia ye 3, 5<sup>th</sup> mo. 1683
