



William Penn, Proprietary & Govern^r of ye Province of Pennsylvania & ye Territories thereunto belonging.

Upon request of George Whiteside, George Reed and Thomas Childs y^t I would grant y^m to take up together three hundred acres of land in ye township next to y^t call'd Concord in ye County of Chester. These are to will & require thee forthwth to survey or cause to be survey'd unto y^m ye aforesd number of acres in ye township mention'd if it be not already taken up according to ye method appointed by me & make returns thereof into my Secretary's office.

Given at Chester ye 19th of ye 12th mo. 1682.
