Surveyed for Georg Woodyard 200 acres of land lying on the east side of ridly creek beginning at a marked poplar being the mark tree of John Houlsons land and running along the sd Houlsons line of marked trees N. E. b. N. 365 perch to a mark whit oak from thence N. N. W. 104 perch to a mark red oak from thence S. W. b. S. 385 perch to a mark red oak standing by ridly creek and down the creek on severall courses to the first menched poplar.
