At ye request of Thomas Minchell yt I would grant him to take up a lott in ye City of Philadelphia proportionable to his purchase of six hundred & twenty five acres. These are to will & require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him a lott in any of ye streets sett out for purchasers of ye like quantity he fencing and building upon ye same according to regulation & make returns thereof into my secretarys office Given at Philadelphia ye 15th of ye 4th mo. 1684
