These are thereffore in ye Proprietarys name to will and require thee fforthwith to survey and lay out unto him ye said numbt of acres (being part of his ffive thousand acres purch-ass) in ye afore mentioned place and make returnes thereof into ye Secretaryes office dated at Philadelphia ye 15-12<sup>th</sup> Mo. 168<sup>2</sup>/<sub>0</sub>
