Surveyed for Barnabass Willcox five hundred ^{oak} acres of land lying on Chester Creek beginning at a marked white oak being the corner mark of richard marsh land and from thence running N. N. W. 80 perch to the above 5^d Chester Creek and running up the sd creek on several courses to a marked white oak being a corner mark of Griffith James land from thence running E. N. E. 130 perch to a marked red oak from thence running S. S. E. 480 perch to a marked white oak and from thence running W. S. W. 188 perch to the first merched white oak.
