These are therefore in ye Proprietarys name to will and require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him ye said number of acres in ye aforesaid county where not already taken up according to ye method of towneshipp appointed by ye Gover^r the seating and improveing the same within six months after ye date of survey and make returne hereoff to ye Secretarys office dated at Philadelphia ye 13th of ye 7^{mo}. 1686.
