



Pursuant to Contract with the Members of the Board of Property of the State of Pennsylv^a dated Nov: 1st 1827. & the authority therein, the above Tract of Land was Surveyed & Calculated by virtue of Order No 3642 granted to Joseph Burrows by the Proprietary government the 12th July 1769. Containing three hundred Acres Six perches & allowance of Six p Ct. Situate in Fayette Township Allegheny County on the north branch of Robinson Run a Branch of Chartiers Creek.

Note, The above Claim of Joseph Burrows Shown by the Green lines, Interfer with a Survey of Samuel Ewing in Right of William Walker upon Warrant Executed Ap: 26th 1786. Containing 418 acs 27 p. The Red lines Show the Extent of Ewings Survey.
