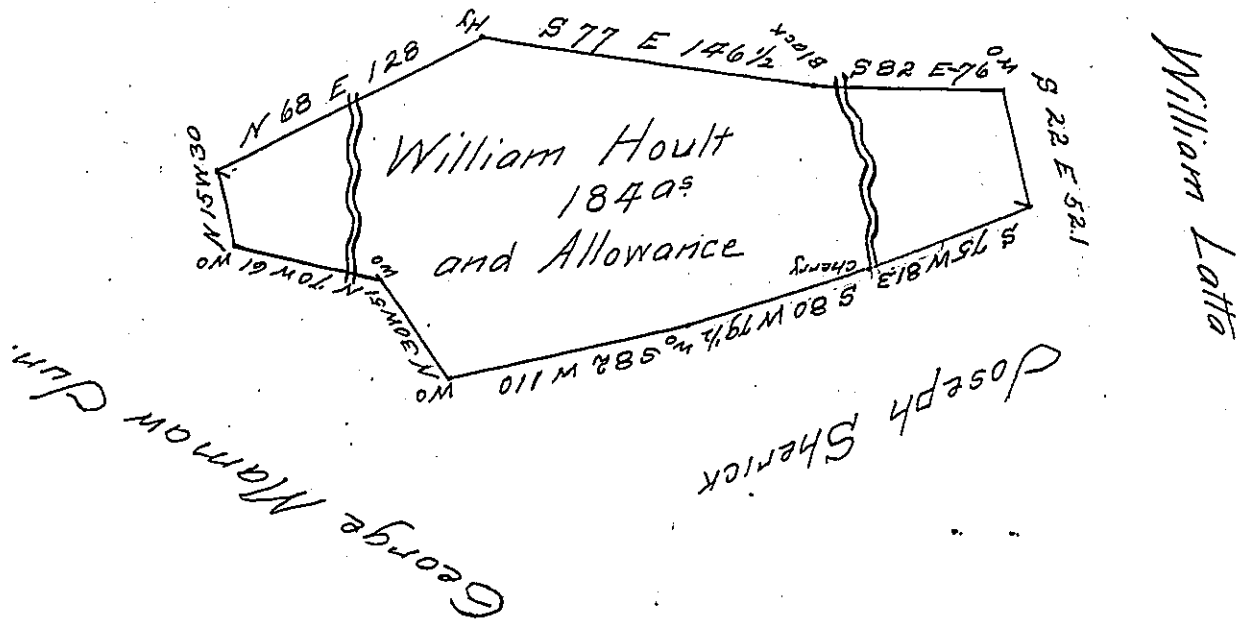


John Overholtz
