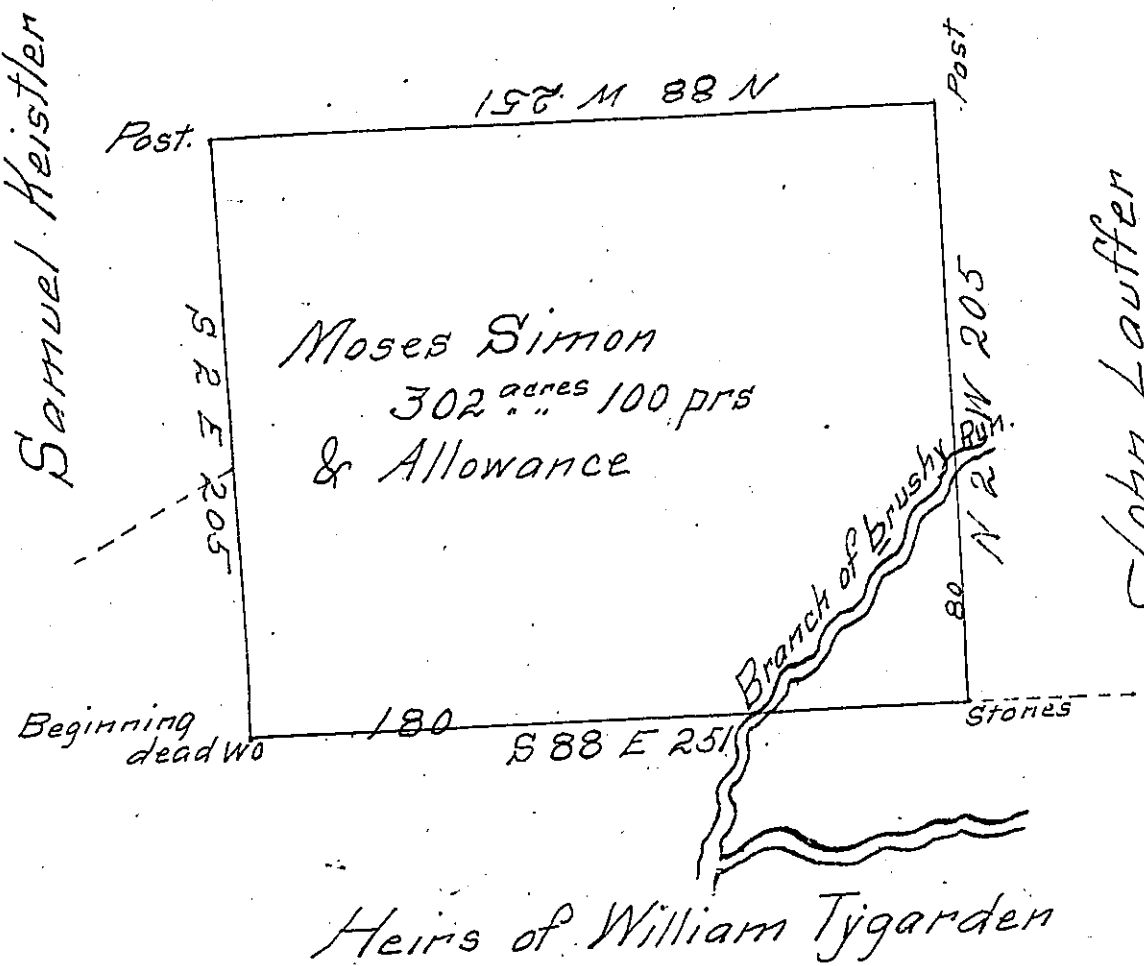


Walter & Lauffer
