At the Request of the Attorneys of Amos Strettell of Dublin in Ireland That we would Grant them our Warr^t to take up the Remainder ~~of George~~ that is yet unsurvey'd of five thousand Acres originally purchase by George Shore of Arthlone in ye 5^d Kingdome Merch^t by Deeds from ye Prop^r dated ye 14th + 15th dayes of ye 2^d Month 1682 & by ye said George Convey'd to the Said Amos by Deeds dated ye 14th + 15th dayes of April 1703 These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey or cause to be Survey'd to the Said Amos Strettell Three thousand three hundred and Eighty Acres of Land in this Province that has not been already Survey'd nor taken up nor is Seated by ye Indians and make Returns thereof into the Secretaries Office. Given under our Hands and the Seal of ye Province at Philad^{ia} the 16th day of the 5th Moth 1712
