



Situate in Turbut Township Northumberland County on the East bra. of Delaware Run about one & a half miles from the path of Muncy Hill Surveyed the 24th day of September 1835 by virtue of an application dated the 5th day of July 1769 No 3610 granted to Robert McNeal Containing three hundred & one acres & One hundred and fifty perches with the usual allowance of Six Per Cent &c

Note the Same tract of land was Surveyed in pursuance of the ___ day of ___ for Margaret Foster in pursuance of her order dated the 3rd day of Ap^l 1769 No 214 And is now owned and occupied by the heirs of Jacob Lilley decd in right of the Said Margaret Foster
