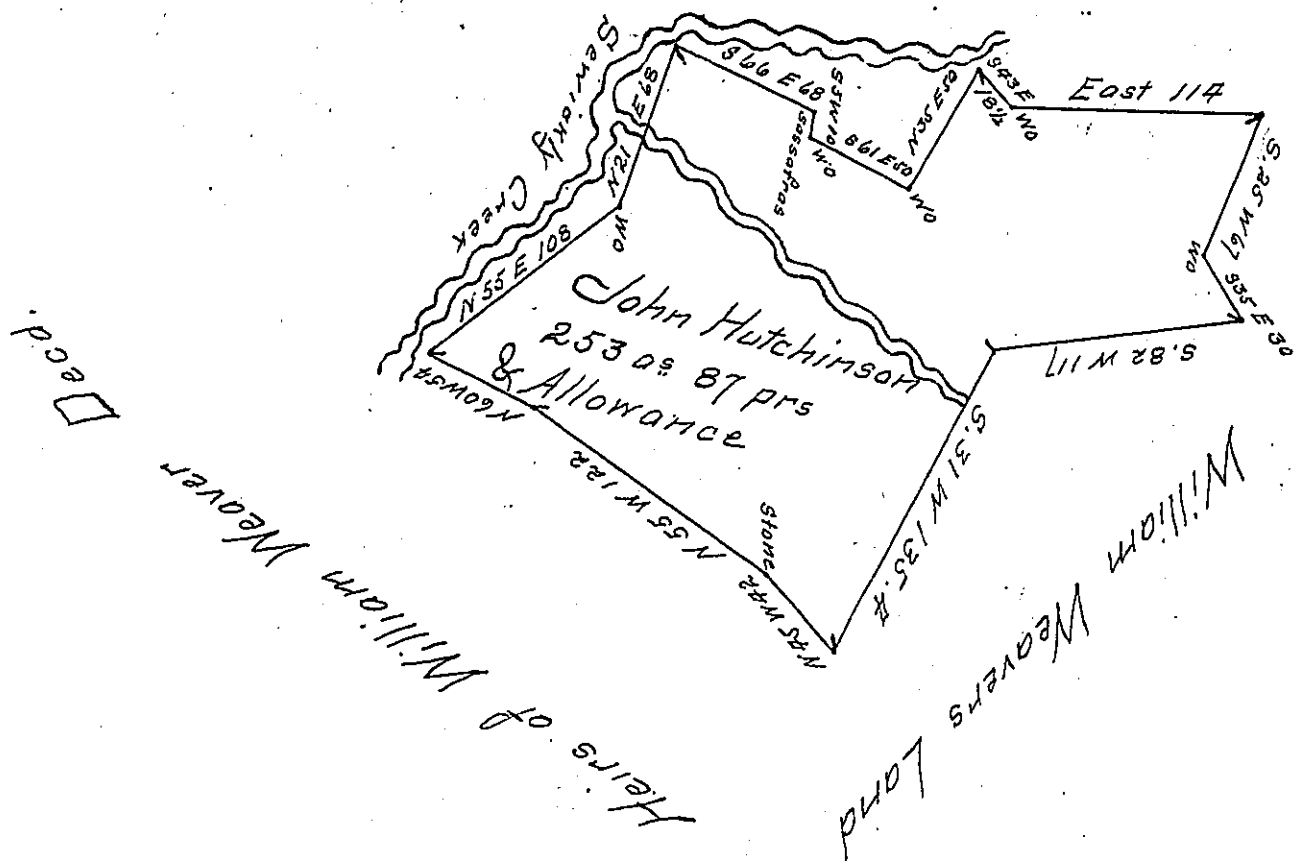


Heirs of Jacob Painter Esq. Decd
