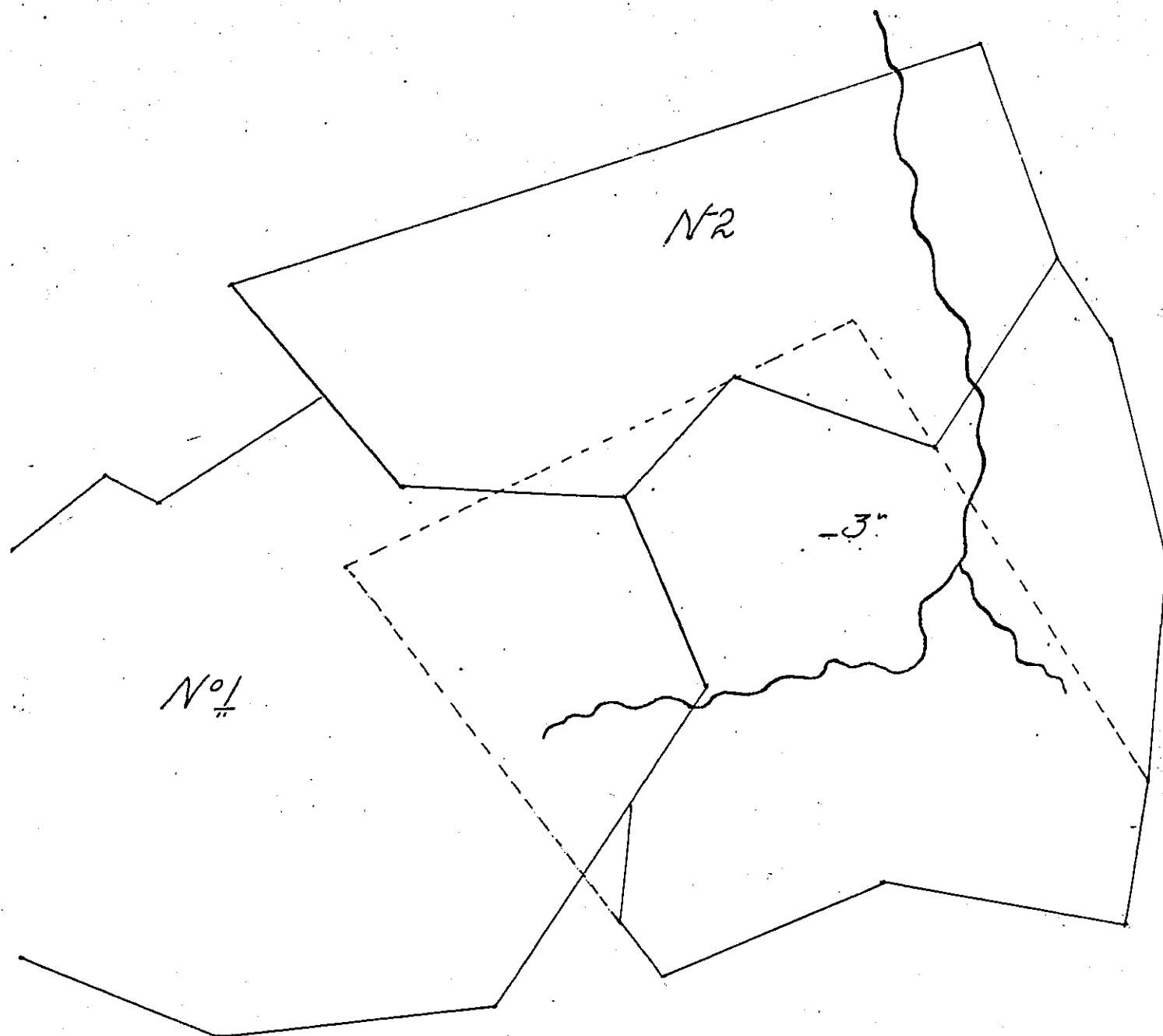


FORM NO 1.



The tract N°1 was surveyed and Returned on ~~an~~ Warrant dated 15<sup>th</sup> of March 1788 for Michael Hoffnagle and James King - Patented

N°2 was Surveyed on an order N° 1909 granted to Bernard Cunningham dated 3<sup>rd</sup> of April 1769 - patented to Wm Shaw - Patd

N°3<sup>rd</sup> Was warranted to James Bovard But the had nothing but an order of resurvey on the place which was executed by James Murry Es and that does not mention warrant but (I know that it is patented) Warrant dated 7<sup>th</sup> November 1785 - Patd

Courses and distances not given.
