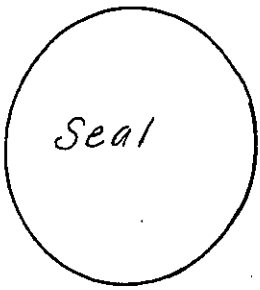

At the Request of Joseph Kirtle That I would grant him a Resurvey on a
Certain Tract of Land Situate in Southampton Township in the County of
Bucks adjoyning on the Lands of In^o Jones Joel Johnson & E. Lust
laid out to Rich^d Wood for 490 Acres (in a former Warr^t from my
Self for 500 Acres, y^e other 10 Acres being Cutt off.) These are to
Require thee forthwith to Resurvey or cause to be Resurvey'd
~~the~~ the Said Tract according to the first Lines of Survey
and ~~the~~ Boundaries thereof And make Returns of thy Resurvey
