



By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietary's Comm^{rs} to me directed bearing date the 6th day of the 2^d month 1702 Resurveyed unto John Eastborne a Tract of Land in Southampton Township in the County of Bucks, beginning at a Post by the Street at Widow Cutler's Corner, Thence by the Said Street N.W. 262 perches to a Post, Then N.E. by John Naylor's surplus land 322 per: to a Post, Then S.E. by the Same 100 per: to a Post, Then by the said Naylor's old Tract S 43 ³/₄ deg^{rs} W 222 per: to a Post, Then by the same S.E. 157 per: to a Post in Widow Cutler's line, Then by the said line S.W. 100 perches to the place of beginning. Containing 305 ³/₄ Acres, Resurveyed the 6th day of the 6th month 1702.
