By virtue of a warrant from the Govern^r & proprietary dated the 8th instant directed to me to Survey or cause to be Survey'd unto Edmond Bennet five hundred acres behind^{or near} Samuell Allens Land near Nishiminih Creek in a place not already taken up & according to the way and methods of Townships appointed by the Govern^r. I hereby authorize thee to Survey & Set out the Said five hundred acres unto him accordingly & if there be any room to that Creek untaken up for which I have not already issued out Warrants & joyning to Sam^l Allens land then to let Edmund Bennet have same there & the rest backward And make me a true return hereof both of the Original field work & protracted figures which by my patent are to remain in my office, dated this 16th 12^{mo} 1682
