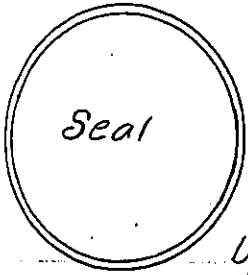

Given under our hands and Seal of the Province at Philad^a the twentieth day of the Twelfth Month in the Third year of the Reign of Queen Anne Over Engl^d & ye 24th of the Propriet^{rs} Govern^t Annoq^d Domini 1704.
