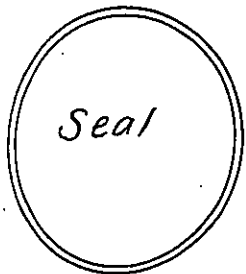


Pensilvania



William Penn Absolute Proprietary and Govern^r in Chief of the Province of Pensilvania and Counties Annexed

At the Request of Samuel Baker heir of Henry Baker deceased That I would grant him a Resurvey on a Tract of Land in Wrights-Town in the County of Bucks laid out to the S^d Hen: Baker for 400 Acres by Warr^t from my Comm^{rs} Also on a Small Tract of Savanna reputed to be 25 Acres, and is part of a Tract of 100 Acres laid out by my Ord^r to Tho: Hudson in my Mann^r of Highlands: These are to require thee forthwith to resurvey or cause to be resurveyed ~~and to make a true and correct Survey~~ the said two Tracts according to their ~~own~~ Boundaries and first lines of Survey and make exact Returns thereof into my Secretaries Office
