



Resurveyed the 15th day of the 11th Month 1701 by Virtue of A Warrant from the Governour dated the 11th of the 11th Month 1700. unto — Samuel Baker four hundred and thirty eight Acres in Wrights-towne in the County of Bucks. Beginning at a Corner marked White Oake at the Town parke thence Wt 38 deg: 11° by Thomas Coleman's Land 267 perches to a Corner marked Spanish Oake over Randal's Creeke, Then N.E. by Derricks and parlets land 409 perches to a Corner marked black Oake Then South 372 perches to a Corner post. Then S.W. by the Town parke 113 perches to the place of beginning. Certified under my hand.
