

Pursuant to a warrant under the hand and Seal of the Proprietary and Governour bearing date the first day of the 12th month 170^f Granting unto Joseph Thatcher and his brother Bartholomew (Executors of ^{the} will of Richard Thatcher old purchaser of one thousand acres) a Survey on three hundred and fifty acres of land in this province. There Survey'd unto Samuel Beaks purchaser under said Joseph & Bartholomew a Tract of land in Soulberry Township in the County of Bucks beginning at a Post by a black oak at the Corner of Stephen Beaks his land from thence extending North West by Paul Wolf's & Thomas Carus land one hundred and seventy five perches to a Post from thence by Ezra Crose dals land North east three hundred and twenty perches to a post near a forked black oak from thence South east by Vacant land 175 to a black oak sappling from thence by Stephen Beaks's land three hundred and twenty perches to the place of Beginning containing three hundred and fifty acres Survey'd by Jno Cutler the 15th of the 8th month 1702.
