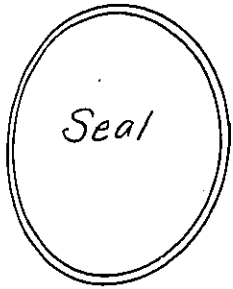


Pennsylvania



By the Commissioners of Property

At the Request of J<sup>no</sup> Brock That we would Grant him to take up five hundred Acres of Land in that Tract called the great Swamp in the County of Bucks for which he hath agreed to pay to the Proprietors use Sixty pounds within three Months,

These are to Authorize thee to Survey or cause to be Survey'd to the Said John Brock the Said quantity of five hundred Acres of Land that has not been already Survey'd either to y<sup>e</sup> Proprietor or to any other persons use in the Said place and contiguous to the Surveys already made there and make Return thereof into y<sup>e</sup> Secretaries Office. Which Survey in case the Said John — Comply with the Agreem<sup>t</sup> afores<sup>d</sup> Shall be valid, otherwise the Same Shall be void as if it had never been made nor this Warr<sup>t</sup> ever Granted. Given under our hands and y<sup>e</sup> Seal of the Province at Philad<sup>ia</sup> the Second day of November A.D. 1713
