Whereas there has been laid out to William Beaks at Quaticlassy, in the County of Bucks, above the Mannor of Highlands five hundred and eighty Acres of Land in right of his Original purchase, of 1300 Acres from the Proprietary w^{ch} Land was Granted by the S^d William or did Some way descend to his Son Stephen Beaks.

And whereas the Lines of the S^d Land having been Confused and pplexed Phineas Pemberton late Surveyor did in the Year 1701 obtain from the Propriet^{ry} a Warr^t of Resurvey directed to the then Surveyor General for resurveying the S^d Land with this Condition that the S^d Phineas Should fix and regulate the Lines of the S^d Tract as little Injurious to the neigbouring Lands as might be

But the S^d Surveyor General as well as the S^d Surveyor being both Since deceased, These are to Require and Command thee forthwith to Resurvey the S^d five hundred and eighty Acres of Land in the place afores^d by Lines as near as may be agreeing with the first

Bounds as laid out by Israel Taylor and make Returns into the General Surveyor's Office at Philadelphia where this Warrant is to remain and a copy thereof to be delvd thee Certified by the Secretary, Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} 17th 6^{mo} 1702 To John Cutler Surveyor } of the County of Bucks
