William Penn Absolute Proprietary and Govern^r in Chief of the Province of Pensilvania and Counties Annexed

At the Request of Elizabeth Beaks Executrix of Stephen Beaks That I would grant her a Resurvey on a certain Tract of Land Situate in Bucks County above the Mannor of Highlands laid out to W^m Beaks father of the S^d Stephen deceased for five hundred and eighty Acres. These are to require thee forthwith to resurvey or cause to be resurveyd the Said Tract of Land according to the first Lines of Survey and Boundaries thereof and make Returns into my Secretaries Office, Given under my hand and Seal at Pensbury the 31st day of the third Month 1701.
