Whereas James Harrison on behalf of John Boncraft hath ^{late purchaser} requested me y^t I would grant him One Thousand Acres of Land and (I having his Request answerd.) is willing to take up part thereof These therefore are to will & require thee forthwth to Survey or Cause to be Survey'd unto him five hundred Acres in ye County of Bucks Where not already taken up according to ye Method of Townships appointed by me, & make returns thereof into my Secretary's Office Given at Philadelphia ye 17th of ye 11th mo 1683.

on this Side Neshemines nor beyond, near the Govern^r's Manners & lands
