At ye Request of Nathanael Allen, Purchaser of Two Thousand Acres yt we would grant him to take up Seven hundred & fifty Acres in ye County of Bucks in ye Township of Warminster these are to will & require thee in ye Proprietarys name to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him ye sd Number of Acres in ye aforesaid County & township provided it be not already taken up he Seating & improving ye same wth two Settle^m^{ts} wth Six Months from ye Date of Survey and make returns thereof into ye Secretarys Office.

Given at Philadelphia ye 9th of ye 11th mo 1684.
