



Resurveyed the 14th day of the 11th month 1701, By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietarie and Governour directed to Edward Penington bearing date the 1st day of the 1st month 170^o, And pursuant to a Warr^t from the Said Edward Penington to me directed bearing date the 4th day of the 1st month 170^o Unto William Derrick One hundred forty Eight acres neare Wrightstown in the County of Bucks, Beginning at a White Oake in Samuel Bakers line being also William Parlet's Corner, Thence by the Said Parlet's Line N.W. 192 perches to a Hickery, Then S.W. 124 perches to a Black Oak, Then by Vacant land S.E. 192 per. to a Post, Then by the Said Samuel Bakers line N.E. 124 per to the place of Beginning.
