



By virtue of a Warrant from Jacob Taylor Surveyor General pursuant to a Warrant from the Commissioners of Property bearing date the 5th day of the 11th month 1714. Surveyed & laid out unto Anthony Burton a tract of Land in Buckingham in Bucks County— Beginning at a Post at Enoch Pearson's Corner, from thence extending South West by vacant Land Eighty Eight perches to a White Oak. Then North West by John Reynolds's Land One hundred Eighty two perches to a Spanish Oak. Then by Land laid out to Thomas Bye North East Eighty Eight perches to a Post. Then South East by Enoch Pearson's Land One hundred Eighty two perches to the place of beginning— Containing One hundred Acres Laid out the Eleventh day of May Anno Domini 1715.
