



By virtue of a Warrant from the Comm^{rs} of Property bearing date the 11th of ye 4th mo: 1712 to Survey unto John Decow ^{1000.005} in Right of Isaac Decow purchaser of 2500 Acres, Surveyed and laid out unto the S^d John Decow a tract of Land in Hilton township in Bucks County Beginning at a Post in the County Line from thence Extending North West by the S^d Line 220 perches to a Post, Then North East by Vacant & James Logan's Land 365 perches to a heap of Stones by a White Oak, Then by the S^d James Logan's Land South East 220 perches to a Post, Then South West by Vacant Land 365 perches to the place of beginning Containing five hundred acres. Surveyed the 12th of the 6th month 1715, Given under my hand.
