



Bucks Co South 340

By virtue of a Warrant from the Commissioners of Property bearing date the 17<sup>th</sup> of 9.ber 1715. Surveyed & Laid out unto John Edwards a tract of Land in the great Swamp in Bucks County begining at a White oak in Joseph Jones's Line, ffrom thence extending by the S<sup>d</sup> Line South One hundred & Sixty perches to a Post by a White Oak at Edward Roberts Corner, Then by the S<sup>d</sup> Edward Roberts Land & Vacant <sup>West</sup> Two hundred & fifty perches to a Post by a white oak, Then by Vacant North 160 perches to a Small white Oak, Then East by vacant 250 perches to the place of begining, Containing two hundred & fifty acres, Laid out the 30<sup>th</sup> of the 1<sup>st</sup> month 1716.
