


Pursuant to a warrant from the proprietors Comissrs of prynty beareing date ye the 4th of the 2^d month 1702 directed unto me I do Certify that I have Reasurveyd for Samuell Carpenter a Certain Tract of Land part in the County of Philladelphia and part in ye County of Bucks, begineing at a Corner Stak deviding it from John Palmors Land in a Line of ye Maner of Mooseland from thenc by the Said Line of marked trees and Said Maner Land and the Land of Peter Chambrline North East 472 perches to a Stak by an old Stump of a gum tree in a line deviding the County of Philladelphia and Bucks County, from thenc by the Said Line of Marked trees North West: 658 perches to a blak OK marked, from thenc into ye County of Bucks by a Line of marked trees North East 320 perches to a whit OK marked, from thenc by a line of marked trees North West: 414 perches to a blak OK marked being a Corner deviding it from Henry Wadys Land, from thenc by the Said Wadys Land and Line of marked trees South West: 320 perches to a Stak by a Wit OK marked in the sd Line deviding the Counties afor sd from thenc by the Said Line of marked trees North West 360 perches to a Whit OK marked, from thenc by a Line of marked trees deviding it from the Reputed Land of ye formerly Mary Blumston now Otter: South West 480 perches to a blak OK marked in a Line deviding it from Joseph ffishers Land, from thenc by the Said Line of marked trees and sam Land and the Land of ye afor sd John Palmor South 45 degrees & abt 16 mint East: 1432 perches to ye plac of begineing, Containeing 5109 Acers of Land, Reasurveyd ye 14th of ye moth aforesaid and is according to ye bounds above described. Returned into ye Generall Survey^rs Offic at Philladelphia ye 12th day of ye fourth mo^o Ensueing.
