to Survey or cause to be Surveyed unto him a Lott in ye City as  
Convenient as maybe, he fenceing in & building upon ye  
Same within Six months from ye date of Survey, and make  
returns thereof into ye Govern<sup>rs</sup> Secretarys Office.
