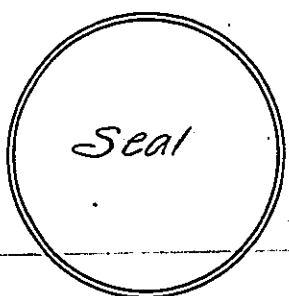


Pensilvania

At the Request of Richard Parker That in behalf of Richard Sneed of Bristol we would Grant him a Resurvey on a certain Tract of Land laid out to the S^d Richard on the River Skuykill for two hundred Acres in right of his Original Purchase of fifteen hundred Acres, Scituate between the Lands of Cha: Jones and Cha: Hartford

These are to require thee forthwith to resurvey the S^d Tract according to its first Bounds and true Lines of Survey and make Returns into the General Surveyors office at Philadelphia where this Warrant is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd to thee Certified by ye Secretary, Given under our Hands and the Seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} the 30th of ye 4th moth 1702
