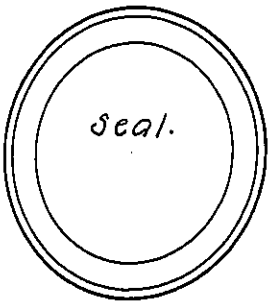


Pensylvania ss.



By the Commissioners of Property.

Upon an agreement made some time ago with Benjamin Moulder of Rockland Manor for one hundred acres of Land in or near the said Manor where one John Garret formerly settled without license, for which the said Benjamin is to pay to the use of the Proprietary Trustees Thirty pounds money of ye said province one Moiety thereof in hand & ye other within six months after ye date hereof and also the yearly quitrent of one Bushel of good winter wheat for the same. These are to Authorise and Require thee to Surveyor Cause to be Surveyd unto the said Benjamin Moulder the said one Hundred acres of Land including within the same the Settlement made by the said John Garret and make Returns thereof into the Secretarys Office which Survey in case the said Benjamin fulfill the above agreement shall be Valid otherwise the same is to be void as if it had never been made nor this warrant ever granted Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 29th of the 5th month Anno Dni. 1720.
