I have layed out for Thomas Macer a tract of Land situate on the South side of Brandewin Creek beginning at A bounded post being A Corner of Georg Pierce Land then by his line north 400 pch. to A bound^{* line left out} Spanish oak then South by Christopher Pennocks line 400 pch. to A post then East 200 p^{ch} to the place of begining surveyed for 500 Acres of land the 26 day of the 10th month 1700 p^e.
