



By ye Comissioners impower'd to grant Lotts & Lands in the Province of
Pennsylvania & ye Territories thereunto belonging.

At ye Request of Thomas Mayleigh in right of Robert Greneway, Purchas-
er of fifteen^{hundred} acres, yt we would grant him to take up five hundred acres of Land in
part thereof in ye County of Chester. These are therefore in ye Proprietary's
Name to will & require thee forthwith to Survey or cause to be Survey'd unto him
ye aforesd Number of acres in ye sd County where not already taken up, accord-
ing to ye method of Township appointed by ye Governr, he Seating & im-
proving the Same with in Six months from ye Date of Survey and make Returns
thereof into ye Secretarys Office, Philadelphia the 17th 12th mo 1684.
