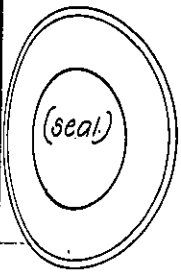


Pensilvania:

At the Request of Evan Prythry that I would grant him a Resurvey on
a certain Tract of Land in Radnor Township by him purchased of David
Powel reputed to contain one hundred and eleven Acres. These are to re-
quire thee forthwith to Resurvey or cause to be resurvey'd the said Tract
of Land according to the first Lines & Bounds of Survey and make Re-
turns thereof into my Secretaries Office. Given under my Hand and
Seal at Philadelphia the 20th of the third Month 1701.
