I have surveyd & Laid out unto Clement Plumstead and Sarah Hall one thousand acres of Land Granted by the Proprietary to their Father William Plumstead Lying on a Branch of Brandywine Creek in the County of Chester Beginning at a Post at Corner of Jonathan Wynne's Land Thence north four hundred and six perches to a post Thence South four hundred and six perches to a third post Then by a Line of the said Jonathan Wynn's Land west three hundred & ~~nine~~ ninety four perches to the Place of Beginning surveyd May the 4th 1708.
