Then surveyed for Charles pickering 186 acres of Land Lieng on the west side of ridly creek begining at a marked white oak standing by the sd Creek being the corner marke of Eustice Andres Land and runing along the sd Eustice Andres line of marked trees w. b. N. 140. per tch to a marked red oak and from thence w. 145. per tch to a marked black oak and from thence runing N. 98 per tch to a marked beetch standing by ridly creek and from thence runing down the said creek on severall courses to the first menched white oak
