These are therefore in ye Proprietarys name to will and require Thee, that after ye overplus of ye said tract of Land be taken out according to ye Directions of a warrt of this days date this day) To Survey and Layout unto Each of them their Respective proportion in Such Manner as they shall most generally agree amongst themselves and make Returne thereof to ye Secretarys office Dated at Philadelphia the 12th day of ye Eleventh mo. 1699. the Road to be allowed
