survey of his plantation and the Land about the Same in the County of
Chester that he now dwells upon, formerly laid out to himself for two
hundred and fifty Acres, These are to Require the forthwith to Resurvey
or cause to be resurvey'd unto him his said Plantation and Tract of Land
according to the old Lines thereof, and make Returns thereof into my
Secretaries Office. Given under my Hand and Seal at Philadelphia the
12th day of ye 8th Moth 1700.*
