At ye request of Thomas Rudyard purchaser of five thousand
acres y^t I would grant him to take up his lotts in ye city both in ye front & high
street & proportion of land wth in ye liberties. These are to will & require thee
forthwith to survey or cause to be survey'd unto him ye sd. lotts where they
fell & proportion of land wth in ye Liberties, and make returns thereof into
my secretary's office. Given at Philadelphia ye 6th of ye 4th mo 1684.
