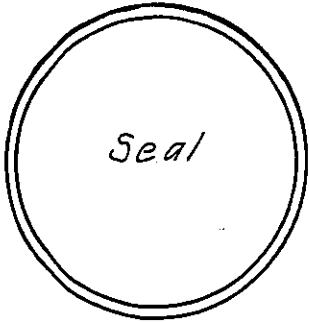

At the Request of John Little John That We would Grant him to take up Two Hundred Acres of Land in the Manner of Rocklands joyning or near to y^e Land laid out to John Pierce for which two hundred Acres he has agreed to pay to the Proprietor's use Sixty pounds of Money of this Province One half thereof on y^e 16th day of Novemb^r next & the other half on the 16th of y^e 3^d Moth next following with lawful Interest for the said last Paym^t These are to Authorize and Require thee to survey or cause to be survey'd to the said John Little John the s^d quantity of two hundred Acres of Land in y^e Manner & place afores^d if to be found Vacant there or in any other adjoining place that is vacant and make Returns thereof into the Secretaries Office Which Survey to be by thee made in case the said John fulfill y^e Agree^mt afores^d shall be valid, otherwise the same shall be void and of no other Effect than as if it had never been made nor this Warr^t ever granted Given under our hands and Seal of y^e Province at Philad^{ie} the 20th day of the 4th Moth 1712
