

By vertue of a war^t directed for the survaiying of fourty thousand acers
of land to the purches^{ts} of north and South Wales & Counties annexed
I heareby certiefy that there was survaid and laid out unto John
Robart purches^t of five hundred acers a certaine tract of land
upon the west sid- of Schoolkroole beginneing in the line of Thomas
John Thomas land to the northward of Radnor Township from thenc- east
-north east one hundred and fourty perches to a tree marked from
thenc- north-northwest one hundred seventy one perch- from thenc-
west-southwest one hundred and sixty perches to the s^d Thomas
John Thomas land and by the s^d Tho. line of marked trees southeast
~~and~~ & by south one hundred seventy-one perch- to the place of beginne-
ing containeing & laid out for one hundred & fifty acers of land.
Laid out 12 2^d m^o 1696.
