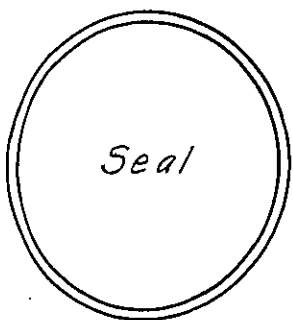


Pennsylvania

These are to require thee forthwith to Resurvey to the said Robert Jones the said Tract of Land according to the first Bounds and Division Lines by which it was at first laid out and divided, and make Returns into the general Surveyors Office at Philad^{ia} where this Warr^t is to remain and a Copy thereof to be deliv^d to thee certified by the Secretary. Given under our hands and the seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} the 6th of the 2^d Moth 1702
