By Vertue of a warrant from y<sup>e</sup> Proprietary and Govern<sup>r</sup> Bearing date y<sup>e</sup> 9<sup>th</sup> of y<sup>e</sup> 12<sup>th</sup> M<sup>o</sup> 1680: Directed to me, I hereby Certifie into his Secretaryes office that I have Caused to be Surveyed and laid out y<sup>e</sup> 11<sup>th</sup> of y<sup>e</sup> 2<sup>d</sup> Month 1684 unto Latticlet Lloyd, A Certain peece or p<sup>o</sup>rtion of Land Scituate lying and being in y<sup>e</sup> County of Chest<sup>r</sup>, (upon Rent) Beginning at a Corn<sup>r</sup> Marked ~~Begin~~ Red oak from thence NEbE by y<sup>e</sup> Land belonging to W<sup>m</sup> Johnson 200 perches to a Corn<sup>r</sup> post from thence NWbN by a line of trees 84 perches to a Corn<sup>r</sup> Marked white oak from thence SWbW by a line of trees 200 perches to a Corn<sup>r</sup> marked Red oak, from thence SEbS by a line of marked trees 84 perches to y<sup>e</sup> first mentioned place of beginning Containing and Laid out for one hundred and ffive acres of Land And is accordingly Entered and Recorded in my office at Philadelphia this 18<sup>th</sup> of y<sup>e</sup> Third Month 1686
