By virtue of a warrant from ye Proprietary and Govern^r Bearing date ye 6th instant (Directed to me) I hereby certifie into his secretaryes office yt I have caused to be surveyd and set out ye 23^d instant unto Thomas Rudyard purchaser his lott in ye City of Philadelphia containing in breadth fifty-one foot and in length four hundred twenty six foot bounded northward wth Pine street formerly called Valley street eastward wth Delaware front street southward wth a Vacant Lott westward wth ye Second Street from Delaware and is accordingly entred and recorded in my office Philadelphia this 25th of ye 4th moth 1684

To have & to hold the said lott to ye said TR. his heirs & assigns forever to ye onely use & behoofe —
