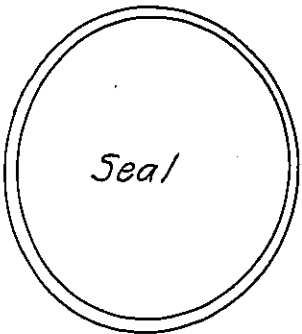

At the Request of John Lewis Sett^r That we would grant him a Resurvey on three hundred and fifty Acres of Land laid out in Haverford within the Welch Tract to Henry Lewis Purchaser under Lewis David by Vertue of a General Warrant from the Proprietary for Laying out the said Tract dated in the first Month 1684 it by Vertue of a Purchase from the s^d Henry now in the s^d John's Possession; These are to require thee forthwith to resurvey to the said John Lewis the s^d quantity of three hundred and fifty Acres of Land and make Returns thereof into the General Surveyors Office at Philadelphia where this Warrant is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delivered to thee certified by the Secretary who is also to take a Copy of thy Return into his Office - Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the 16th day of the 12th Month 1701
