These are therefore in the Proprietary's name to will and require thee forth with to lay out or cause to be laid out unto him that peece of land according to y<sup>e</sup> quantity of his ffront lott and y<sup>e</sup> regulation made thereoff and make returne of y<sup>e</sup> so doing to y<sup>e</sup> Secret<sup>rs</sup> office.
