Surveyed for Eberesor Longstaf 500 acres of Land lying on the west side of darby creek beginning at a marked post being the mark of John Nixon's land and running N 66° E along the S^d Nixon's line of marked trees 380 perch to a marked white ~~red~~ oak standing by darby creek then by the creek on severall courses to a marked red oak and from thence S.W.B.W 385 perch to a marked post and from thence S 67° E to the first mentioned post.
